Cost of the K-9 conference is \$650.00. This includes three training certificates, one lunch, one banquet dinner, and entrance into the exhibitor expo.

St. Johns County Sheriff's Office has kennel space and veterinary services on standby for any emergencies that might arise.

What can be expected one might ask. First, after completion of the conference a team will receive a total of three certifications. One from the ATF for the NORT testing, one from New Mexico Tech for the Response to Bombing Incidents, and an IABTI certificate of training.

There will also be technology vendors to visit after training hours on Monday and Tuesday nights of the conference. Wednesday night there will be a banquet dinner and auction. There are also other activities planned during the week.
